### GCC - Supporting Positive Change in our Community

Two years ago, an organizer with the Greater Cleveland Congregations (GCC) met with our Missions and Community Engagement Committee (now Team) to invite BUMC to join GCC. At the same time, our District Superintendent was encouraging United Methodist congregations to become part of GCC.

GCC is a nonpartisan organization of 38 churches, synagogues, and religious organizations who work collaboratively to advocate for positive change in the Greater Cleveland area. GCC was established in 2011 and is affiliated with sister organizations in other cities.

We started attending their meetings. We met with people within our own congregation and with people who are members of GCC institutions. We formed a GCC ministry team within BUMC and began to informally support some GCC initiatives.

In August, our Leadership Board, with the support of our Missions and Community Engagement Team and our GCC Team, voted unanimously for BUMC to join GCC.

GCC focuses on building personal relationships with each other, with members of our community, and with those who have the power to implement change. Over the years, GCC has supported efforts to improve access to healthcare, to promote fairness in our criminal justice system, to help empower individuals to become voters, and to generally help those who are underserved and underrepresented.

As we learned during Pastor Heidi's recent sermon series our United Methodist Social Principles encourage us to equip our members to be effective advocates for justice in the world, to assist those in need, and to work to eradicate unjust practices, policies, and systems – all actions that are part of GCC's mission.

BUMC has a long tradition of engaging in mission to help those in need. Our involvement with GCC will complement our mission work by giving us opportunities to join with others to support systemic changes which are necessary to build a more just community. This will be another way we can get off our donkeys and live out our United Methodist Social Principles!

## With gratitude...

On behalf of the Petro and Schwendeman families, I want to take a moment to offer my sincere gratitude to the community of Brecksville United Methodist Church for the outpouring of love and support that you have shown us over the last four months following Dana's death.

Beginning her work at Brecksville UMC nine years ago was the realization of a dream for Dana. She cared so deeply about how faith and spirituality are communicated to young people in the church. Dana did everything in her power to ensure that her students felt seen and loved. From her undergrad studies focusing in pre-ministry and young adult literature, to her work in seminary refining her ideas about youth ministry and inclusion, Dana aimed her every intention at creating lasting communities that support and celebrate young people. She was so proud of the students of Brecksville UMC both currently in the youth group and those who've graduated. She found such joy watching students grow together and as individuals, and loved the privilege of being able to play a part in that process.

In our early twenties, as we joined this community, we could not imagine the impact and growth that we would experience. This church loved and supported Dana and me over nearly a decade providing space to explore both creatively and professionally. Cheering us on as we would take chances in music ministry, Dana's reading of the poetry prayers, leading intergenerational Sunday school classes and any number of other ways, and offering a shoulder to lean on through times that felt less like success. Over that time we were fortunate enough to develop deep friendships and a strong support system. Seeing us through seemingly never ending apartment hunts, the isolation of a global pandemic, and the ups and downs of being human.

That support system showed up for me and the Petros day one sitting with us in the grief of Dana's passing. Helping make her service feel so personal with her favorite foods (matzoh ball soup and charcuterie). In the months following, our community has held us in love in so many different ways from the generous donations to the Dana Love Fund to texts/calls, book recommendations, prayers, hugs, meals shared, or just offering to spend time together. Without the support and love from our church community, both quite recent and over the past decade, I cannot say where I would be in processing my grief and loss. So, from the bottom of our hearts, thank you, BUMC.
